**1 Find out if the APICS CSCP program meets your education and training needs.** Visit [www.apics.org/cscp](http://www.apics.org/cscp).

**2 Determine if you are eligible for the APICS CSCP certification exam.**

You must fulfill **ONE** of the following [APICS CSCP exam eligibility requirements](#):

- 5 years of related business experience, OR
- APICS CPIM, APICS CFPIM, APICS CIRM, C.P.M. and two years of related business experience, OR
- Bachelor's degree or equivalent and two years of related business experience.

**3 Use the APICS CSCP Learning System to prepare for the certification exam.**
